

Can you help?

The Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery Department in this hospital is participating in the pilot phase of a national quality improvement programme called the Quality and Outcomes in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery (QOMS). This is to improve care in oral and maxillofacial surgery by learning from our patient's experiences.

What does this involve?

We collect information on treatment and results for every patient undergoing certain procedures at this hospital. We then compare with the results from other hospitals to find out how to provide the best care. It is important that we make sure that similar hospitals are compared with each other. The project would use your postcode, as well as severity of your surgery, and general health information help with this.

Do I have to take part?

If you don't wish to take part please let your surgeon know. You can opt out at any time and all your information will be removed.
