## OMFS NATIONAL CASE-BASED DISCUSSION WORKSHOP

### Course Overview

This national workshop is designed to support OMFS trainees at all stages of training (ST3–ST7), with particular benefit for those progressing towards the FRCS (OMFS) examination. The course focuses on developing a clear, structured approach to clinical cases, enabling trainees to confidently apply this framework in their own departments and exam preparation. Rather than a traditional revision course, this is a highly interactive, supportive learning environment, aimed at building confidence, clinical reasoning, and exam technique.

### Course Format

Candidates will rotate through four consultant-led rooms, each focusing on one section of the FRCS syllabus.

Each session will include:

- Consultant-led viva-style case discussions
- Small group interactive learning
- Exposure to a wide range of exam-relevant scenarios



During the day candidates will work through approximately 48 clinical cases covering the full breadth of the FRCS examination syllabus.

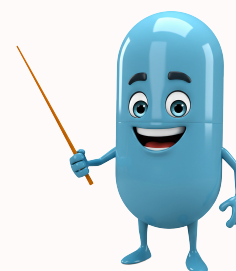
Following the case sessions, faculty will deliver focused teaching highlighting key learning points, structured approaches to answering questions and common examination pitfalls.
