

#### Kanwalraj Moar

- New OMFS Cleft Surgeon appointed at South Thames Cleft Service in April 2020 following retirement of OMFS Cleft Surgeon in post.
- \* No other OMFS Cleft retirements or appointments.
- National Conference of Craniofacial Society of Great Britain and Ireland postponed by 1 year to March 2021 (TBC)
- \* 14th International Cleft and Craniofacial Congress postponed to 11-15th July 2022 (from 2021)
- \* Cleft Collective Studies now restarted although has not received renewal of its funding form MRC.
- \* Cleft Development Group has issued prioritisation guidelines in June 2020, all services have now restarted primary surgery including ABG, but at last check no restarts of cleft orthogonathic surgery.
- New teaching resource of 13 quick cleft topics planned by CFSGBI early next year
- Invited Lecture for the Oral and Maxillofacial Section of Royal Society of Medicine 29th July 2020 -Updates in cleft - adapting to the pandemic era K. Moar

#### SKIN SURGERY SSIG

- responded on behalf of BAOMS with input from Reg Anand to BAD draft clinical guidelines for management of cutaneous SCC 2020
- Applied unsuccessfully following telephone interview for membership of NICE Skin tumours including melanoma: assessment and management committee
- Distributed details of Canvas trial (comparing resorbable vs nonresorbable sutures in skin surgery) to SSig membership – Four sites in North/East Yorkshire entered
- Request support of Council for support of the Priority Setting Partnership an initiative funded by UK Dermatology clinical trials network and the British Society for Dermatological Surgery.
- The aim of the project is to identify via questionnaire the top ten areas of research for skin cancer surgery.
- This project gives the opportunity to cement the role of OMFS in delivering skin cancer surgery.

- Have audited outcomes of close deep margins in cutaneous scalp SCC in North and East Yorkshire, aim to distribute results and then seek other centres in UK to share their results and feed back to speciality and BAD colleagues


