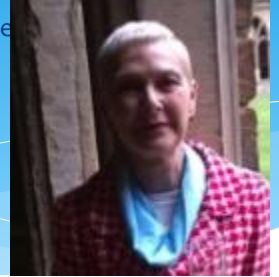

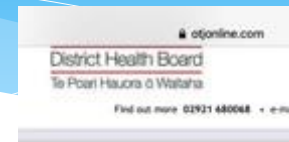

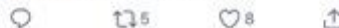

- responded on behalf of BAOMS with input from Reg Anand to BAD draft clinical guidelines for management of cutaneous SCC 2020
- Applied unsuccessfully following telephone interview for membership of NICE Skin tumours including melanoma: assessment and management committee
- Distributed details of Canvas trial (comparing resorbable vs non-resorbable sutures in skin surgery) to SSig membership – Four sites in North/East Yorkshire entered
