

Post CCT Fellowship in Management of Obstructive Sleep Apnoea

Applications for a 4 month post CCT fellowship in the Management of Obstructive Sleep Apnoea based in London are invited.

The fellow would have free access to two established multidisciplinary networks involved in the investigation, diagnosis and management of obstructive sleep apnoea.

The Central London network consists of maxillofacial/orthodontic and ENT surgical departments at Chelsea & Westminster and The Royal National Throat, Nose and Ear Hospitals respectively. The full remit of surgical intervention would be covered, including orthognathic, and soft tissue transoral procedures with facility for robotic assistance. There is strong medical input from The Brompton Centre for Sleep Study and Respiratory Medicine. The fellow would be encouraged to attend sleep endoscopy lists, as well as become competent in the interpretation for polysomnographic and airway imaging studies.

A second network in South West London is centred on St George's Hospital, London. This is a large trust with full representation of surgical and medical specialties. The fellow would be involved with ongoing research into airway flow modelling and volumetric analysis with backing from Imperial University. They would be encouraged to perform audit and research in this field with the aim of publication.

Local funding and funding from BAOMS is being sought.
