TMJ Surgery Post CCT Fellowship - Queens Medical Centre, Nottingham

Applications for a 4-12 month post CCT in TMJ surgery are invited. We would encourage candidates to consider incorporating this as a rotation with 4 month fellowships at Mersey, Nottingham and Oxford . Successful candidates would be exposed to training with 6 specialist TMJ surgeons and a wide range of allied experts providing a broad basis of experience. In Nottingham, Fellows would gain hands on experience with both Biomet and TMJ concepts TMJ replacement systems in addition to level one arthroscopic surgery (with exposure to different arthroscopic systems), open TMJ surgery, condylar head and neck fractures, paediatric ankylosis management with distraction and skull base surgery (if desired). Candidates would also be exposed to MDT clinics and non—surgical management. They would be actively encouraged to undertake audit, prepare publications (this unit has a high publication rate from the lead clinicians' prospective databases) and attend the ESTMJS and SORG meetings.

Funding exists for the Nottingham fellowship based on registrar salary with on call, funding from existing employers and local trusts is being sought in addition to BAOMS and commercial sponsorship of educational courses for Oxford and Mersey.

All three units have a track record of providing high quality surgical training and are committed to producing successful future colleagues with the best possible training and ongoing support.
